

Instruction

Summer School

The Board of Education may sponsor a summer school program providing remedial and enrichment courses at all levels and review courses at the secondary level. Enrichment courses shall carry no credit.

Admission

Attendance in the summer school shall be on a voluntary basis. Transportation will be the responsibility of the parents or guardian, except for students enrolled in special education programs.

1. Elementary

Admission to elementary summer school classes will be limited to those students who will be enrolled in grades K-6 in September of the year of the summer school session and who are current residents.

2. Secondary

Admission to secondary summer school classes for enrichment or noncredit courses must be approved by the Principal. Admission to a review course for credit will be permitted to students previously enrolled in the course but who have not received credit for that course. Credit for courses not offered by the school district may be granted with prior approval from the high school principal and head of the respective department.

3. Tuition

The Board of Education may charge a reasonable fee to each attending child. Nonresidents will be required to pay fees as established by the Board of Education.
