Five Year Strategic Operating Plan

On May 19, 2014, the Thomaston Board of Education reviewed and created a Five-Year District Strategic Operating Plan. By consensus, the Thomaston Board of Education defined the actions for a five-year district strategic plan.

Action Plan

The Five-Year District Strategic Operating Plan shall include self-promotion actions:

- A comprehensive review of all District educational programs and resources,
- The creation of a curriculum review and revisions calendar,
- The development of a Five-Year Teaching and Learning Plan,
- The development of a Student Recruitment and Retention Plan,
- The creation of a prioritized list of facility maintenance and safety/security projects,
- A list of specific actions to increase efficiencies in the use of school facilities, and
- A list of specific actions to expand the use of school facilities to accommodate intradistrict/interdistrict educational programs.

For each of the seven actions identified by the Board of Education, an Action Team will be identified to develop plans for implementation. Each action team will meet to complete the step-by-step directions, timelines, assignments of responsibilities, and cost-benefit analyses for their assigned action. The final action plan will be implemented according to the specified timeline.
